The majority of employers visiting campus focus their presentations on opportunities for undergraduate students. However, there are great reasons for you to attend the sessions:

1. Learn more about the hiring trends in the US job market
2. Discover organizations that may be in a hiring in one of your interest areas.
3. Network with potential employers and gain contact information for your job search

Each employer visit is an opportunity for you to gain information on an organization, who is hiring, and to gain access to relevant contacts for your interest area.
