

Section 15. The viewer's eye travels down the bridge to the bottom of the scroll, where one sees a riderless horse tied next to a sign reading "Branch Wineshop" (脚店). The horse's master has gone into the inn, which also has a towering lattice structure built above its gate. From the gate, a pole extends horizontally bearing the three-strip flag marking a tavern. The middle strip reads "New wine" (新酒). Next to the horse a man brings two bowls and chopsticks to someone who has ordered take-out food. To the right, a woman and small child examine banners from a peddler, while above them a vendor sells rope from his bamboo cart.

At the top of the section, three long, flat houseboats, possibly used for touring, are anchored on the shore of the waterway. The owners of the boat to the right have even designed a shipboard garden of potted plants.
